Volunteer Check

- Register at the front office with your Driver's License the first time. After that, just check in with your name to get your name badge.
- There are two computers up front to log in to track your volunteer hours. You must log in and out. Recording your hours is very important to Binks Forest and your PTA.

- · Please do not come in to volunteer if you are ill.
- * You may feel that you are leaving the teacher short-handed, but it is more

important that our students and teachers stay healthy.

- · Notify the school, myself or PTA if you cannot attend.
- If a child complains of an illness while you are volunteering, notify
 the teacher immediately! The teacher will have knowledge of the
 child's medical history.
- You are not authorized to distribute food, medicine, or other
 products to a student. Many children suffer from a variety of food
 altergies and other aitments. Certain foods, medications, beverages,
 and/or body care products could trigger a negative reaction.

Health E Safety

Know emergency procedures and exits. Follow the established emergency plan.

- School may have drills going on during the time you are volunteering, please follow protocols.
- Learn the proper use of school equipment. If you have been injured at school or while attending a school-sponsored event, contact the front office to fill out an accident report. While working as a volunteer, you are covered by the School District's Workers' Compensation coverage.
- Never leave a student alone. Never allow a student to leave school without checking out through the main office. Never release a student to a person who is not a staff member even if they are a relative.
- If an accident involving a student occurs, immediately notify a staff member. Never move a student involved in an accident. A member of the school staff will initiate proper procedure for accidents.
- If you have doubts about a situation, ask someone with authority.

Please Do!



- . Set a good example by using proper manners and behavior.
- Be careful of what you say and do especially in the media workroom and hallways.
- Follow the staff/student dress code when volunteering. Your attire should be neat, clean and appropriate.
- . Be respectful of the staff and the school.
- Be friendly...with a smile \odot and a thank you, you can accomplish miracles.
- . Be patient with the equipment in the copy room.
- . Help each other! Many new volunteers

Please Don't



- Discipline a student. Classroom supervision and student discipline are the responsibilities of the teacher and school. If you see a student misbehaving, notify the teacher in charge.
- •Use a cell phone in front of students, in the hallways or in the media work room while volunteering.
- Give students medication, food, candy, or any type of snacks unless approved and overseen by the classroom teacher.
- •Gossip! Anything you may hear or see regarding students, parents or teachers & staff while you are volunteering should remain confidential.
- · Enter the Teacher Mailroom. This area is strictly prohibited.
- Disrupt your own child's classroom when volunteering elsewhere in the school. (Kids will love to see you but please do not disturb learning)
- ·Look at or touch materials on a teacher's desk unless asked to do so.
